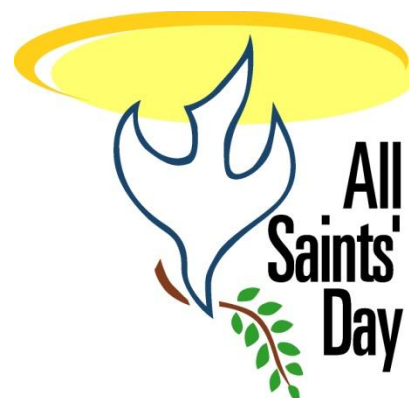
Chapter Annual Meeting: October 28th

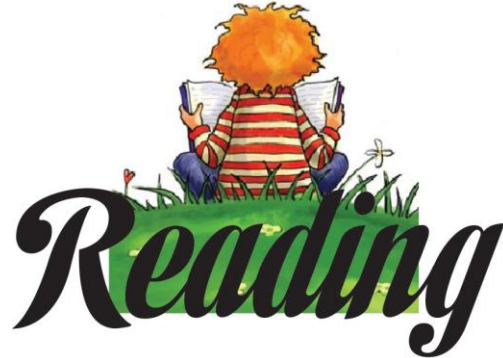
